

Gustav Mahler Music Weeks Toblach 2024

July 13 - 29

Once again, the artistic director of the Gustav Mahler Music Weeks Toblach, Josef Lanz, has put together a captivating program - a variety of symphony concerts, ensembles, and outstanding soloists in the "marvelous" holiday region 3 Zinnen Dolomites, complemented by an important symposium with renowned musicologists from all over the world.

Symphonic masterpieces

The opening concert promises to be a fascinating experience: Mahler's 4th Symphony in a new arrangement for chamber orchestra, plus works by Felix and Fanny Mendelssohn, with the Jewish Chamber Orchestra Munich under Daniel Grossman and the celebrated soprano Chen Reiss. On July 17, the poignant final movement of Mahler's 3rd Symphony and Max Bruch's popular 1st Violin Concerto will be performed by the Mahler Orchestra Toblach and the 18-year-old virtuoso Yuki Serino. On July 19, the audience can expect the "Mahler highlight", his monumental 6th Symphony, interpreted by the Orchestra Sinfonica di Milano under Michael Sanderling. The 8-piece chamber ensemble of the Orchestra for the Earth will play arrangements of Mahler's Adagio from the 10th Symphony and works by Alban Berg and Richard Strauss. Finally, the chamber orchestra Camerata Vitilo under Yuki Kasai will present works by Mozart, Beethoven and Charles Ives.

Intimate chamber music and fascinating Ensembles

Agnes Palmisano, Andreas Teufel and Daniel Fuchsberger introduce Viennese Lieder to mark the 150th birthday of Ludwig Gruber and Arnold Schönberg. The renowned French pianist Lucas Debargue enters the world of Beethoven, Fauré and Chopin. The Arcadia Quartet & friends honors Hubert Stuppner on his 80th birthday, while works by Antonin Dvořák are performed by the young Ensemble Esperanza from Lichtenstein and the established Czech Škampa Quartet.

Innovation and discovery

The El Cimarrón Ensemble under Clemens Heil will give world premieres of works by young composers, together with soprano Alexandra Lampert-Raschke and the Pustertal Valley brass quintet Die Blechzinnen. This ensemble will also play at the Komponierhäuschen. Young musicians will perform with the Euregio Youth Wind Orchestra and there will be a free music workshop for children entitled "Discover the world of sounds". Author Gabriele Reiterer will present her book about Mahler's daughter Anna Mahler, and the exhibition "Das Lied von der Erde" (The Song of the Earth), a collaboration between the Gustav Mahler Music Weeks and artists from the UNIKA association, will be on display throughout the festival.

Musicological exploration

The unmistakable sound of Gustav Mahler's music is the focus of the international musicological symposium "Gustav Mahler's Sound: Between Creative Process, Interpretation and Reception". From July 18 to 20, renowned experts from all over the world will shed light on Mahler's sound world from various perspectives, with lectures and discussions in German and English.
